

## GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. The subject and validity of the General Terms and Conditions

- 1.1. The present general terms and conditions (hereinafter referred to as **GTC**) constitute these General Terms and Conditions, which govern the rights and obligations between the contracting parties in the provision of the Service.
- 1.2. The subject of the present GTC covers the provision of the Services provided by Kinepict as defined below in the present GTC.
- 1.3. The User shall comply with the provisions set forth in these GTC by its employees, officers, directors and/or contributors in the use and application of the Software. The User shall be responsible for the conduct of such persons and any non-compliance or breach of the provisions of these GTC.
- 1.4. This GTC shall apply to all contractual relations relating to the provision of the Service by Kinepict. The GTC shall form an integral and inseparable part of the Individual Agreement between Kinepict and the User, the User is aware of, acknowledges and accepts the provisions of the GTC.
- 1.5. The GTC are valid indefinitely from the date of publication until revoked.
- 1.6. Capitalized terms used in Section 2 below and in the Annexes to these GTC shall have the meanings ascribed to them in Section 2 below and in the Annexes to these GTC.
- 1.7. The Kinepict undertakes to publish the content of this GTC on <https://kinepict.com/resources/downloads>, to make it available for download from the Product Support Site and the User may request a copy of it. The Kinepict has the right to unilaterally amend the GTC (the circumstances giving rise to the amendment: changes in legislation, business interests, changes in the company). The Kinepict will publish the amendments on the website and notify registered/previously registered Users of the changes by e-mail, on the basis of which the User has the right to withdraw from or terminate the contract. The Kinepict reserves all rights in respect of the Website, any part of the Website and the content displayed thereon, and the distribution of the Website. The downloading, electronic storage, processing and sale of the contents of the website or any part thereof without the written consent of Kinepict is prohibited.

### 2. Definitions

**“Authorized Person”** means the person, who is specified in the Individual Agreement.

**“Devices”** means the devices specified in Annex 1.

**“Help Desk”** means a type of Service provided by Kinepict to the User set forth in present GTC 5.5.

**“Individual Agreement”** means the agreement containing specific provisions relating to the User and the provision of the Service, which shall be read in conjunction with the GTC in force from time to time. The Individual Agreement may validly contain specific provisions other than the GTC.

**“Installation”** means a type of Service provided by the Kinepict to the User set forth in present GTC 5.3.

**“Party or Parties”** The Kinepict and the User separately or jointly.

**“Trial Period”** means the period during which the User is not obliged to pay any Fee to Kinepict, and is entitled to terminate the contract with immediate effect by unilateral declaration.

**“Services”** means all the services specified in the Individual Agreement and provided by the Service Provider which are part of the services specified in the Annexes to these GTC and which are covered by these GTC.

**“Software”** means the Kinepict Medical Imaging Tool Software, owned and operated exclusively by Kinepict, as a unique software product.

**“Training”** means a type of Service provided by the Kinepict to the User set forth in present GTC 5.4.

**“User”** means the legal person, who initiates the conclusion of an agreement, or uses the Services described in the present GTC or in any Individual Agreement based on the present GTC or way of an implied act or omission, in good faith.

**“User’s Manual”** means a detailed description of the Software and the description of the use of the Software.

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### **3. Software**

- 3.1. The Kinect undertakes to provide one or more of the Services specified in these GTC and identified in the Individual Agreement on the basis of these GTC and in accordance with the provisions of the Individual Agreement.
- 3.2. The Kinect and the User agree that in the course of its day-to-day operation the User shall be entitled to use the Software as set forth in the GTC and individual agreement, for which the User shall pay the Kinect the fee set forth in the Individual Agreement.
- 3.3. The Software remains the sole property of Kinect during the term of validity of the GTC and even after the termination of the Individual Agreement.
- 3.4. Kinect grants the User a non-exclusive, non-transferable limited license to the Software for both the trial period and the fee payment period. On the basis of the limited license, only the User or employees of the User may use the Software only in order to execute examinations in accordance with the indication fixed in the CE or FDA marking and in accordance with the clinical evidence. User may use only on his/her internal electrical network and User shall not access the Software outside the facility of the User. Parties agree that the User may use the Software only for examinations in a manner and on body parts as it is specified in the Software's User's Manual. User may only use the Software, display and test the Software functions on screen, but shall not make copy, disclose, transmit, display the Software to any third party and may not disclose any information about its use to any third party. The Kinect excludes the user to offer sublicense in connection with the Software to any other third party. Parties state that the rules of use determined in this paragraph shall also be applicable for the employees of User and User shall be liable to Kinect in case of the violation of the Agreement by its employees in the same manner as if the Agreement had been violated by User.
- 3.5. The patent solely owned by the Kinect, needed for the application of the Software, the Kinect provides the User a right of exploitation limited in space, time and way of use as the license on the Software is limited according to the provisions of the present GTC. The extent of the right of limitation may under no circumstances exceed the extent which is required to the use of the Software determined in the present GTC.
- 3.6. The User by accepting the present GTC that the know-how used during the Trial Period the Software is the exclusive intellectual property of Kinect. With regard to the know-how, Kinect only provides limited right of exploitation to User during the Trial Period in the present Agreement. User may use the know-how to the extent which is necessary for the use of the Software, it may not disclose the know-how to any other third party and it may not grant permission to any third party to its use. The description of the know-how handed over simultaneously with the availability of the Software is determined in Annex 1. All technical, economic or organizational knowledge, solution, experience, or combination of thereof which are overhanded by the Kinect to the User and which are recorded in a manner that is suitable for their identification, shall be considered know-how.
- 3.7. The User shall have access to the Software by its installation on the Users Devices by the Kinect. The Kinect is not responsible for ensuring that all settings of the Software are appropriate for executing individual diagnoses.
- 3.8. The Kinect shall not be liable for any damages in connection with the use of any diagnostic, result, image, opinion, position or opinion of the Software, nor shall it be liable for any monetary or non-monetary liability.
- 3.9. In the event of termination of the Individual Agreement, the User shall delete the Software on the date of termination of the Individual Agreement.

### **4. Trial Period**

- 4.1. Parties agree that the day following the completion of the Training, which is realised after the competition of the Installation starts the Trial Period.
- 4.2. During the Trial Period, the User is entitled to use the Software as set forth in the present GTC and individual agreement.

### **5. Services of Kinect**

- 5.1. Kinect will provide the following Services to the User in the framework of the present GTC:
  - a) the Installation of the Software,
  - b) The Training of User's employees as for the use of the Software,

c) performing certain tasks related to the maintenance and functioning of the Software (Helpdesk).

## 5.2. Installation of the Software

- 5.2.1. Kinepict undertakes to install the Software on the Users Devices at the location indicated by the User within 15 days after signing the Individual Agreement. The user shall certify the Installation by signing the installation report fixed in Annex 4 of the present GTC. Parties agree that any delay by the User excludes any simultaneous delay of Kinepict.
- 5.2.2. The installation report shall specify which technical conditions necessary for the functioning of the Software are missing at the location of the installation of the Software. By accepting the present GTC, the User acknowledges that if it does not ensure the technical conditions specified in Annex 1 of this GTC, the Software will not function.
- 5.2.3. The User shall have access to the Software by its Installation by Kinepict. The Kinepict is not responsible for ensuring that all settings of the Software are appropriate for executing individual diagnoses.

## 5.3. Training

- 5.3.1. The Kinepict undertakes to provide the Training for the use of the Software as it is fixed hereunder.
- 5.3.2. Within 20 business days from the Installation of the Software and at a location and time fixed with the User, Kinepict shall provide on-site Training to the specialist designated by the User to demonstrate the functioning of the Software, all its functions, settings and outputs related to the Software. The duration of the training is approx. 3x8 hours. The User undertakes to be at Kinepict's disposal and to provide the necessary premises and personnel for the use of the Software, and to assure the presence of employees who will use the Software. User shall only be entitled to use the Software after completion of the training set out in this Point.
- 5.3.3. The specialist designated by the User shall certify the completion of the Training by signing the educational checklist attached as Annex 4 to the present GTC. Parties declare that Kinepict provides the Training for User without any consideration, especially training fee unless the Parties later agree differently.
- 5.3.4. Parties agree that if the specialist designated by User does not attend the training provided by Kinepict, Kinepict shall have no liability with regard to the use of the Software.

## 5.4. Help Desk

- 5.4.1. Kinepict provides the following services during the cooperation:
- a) Help Desk Support: system support related to the Software, available by phone on business days between 9 am and 6 pm (CET). By accepting the present GTC, the User acknowledges that not only the Kinepict but also third parties being in contractual relationship with the Kinepict in order to provide the Help Desk support are also entitled to provide Help Desk Support to User. In the latter case, the table indicated in Annex 6 contains the contact details of these third parties.
  - b) Support Service: correction of errors occurring during the functioning of the Software in order to ensure the formation of images required for the User's examinations. Error acknowledgements are received and resolved on business days between 9 am and 6 pm CET.
- 5.4.2. Annex 5 of the present GTC indicates the timeframe of reception of error acknowledgements and the categories of errors. It is in Kinepict's competence to determine the category of the error acknowledgements.
- 5.4.3. The Kinepict shall not be required to modify or improve the Software for any purposes different from its initial function and the Kinepict only has to perform its Support Service by maintaining the integrity of the Software.
- 5.4.4. Within the framework of the Help Desk Support User shall contact Kinepict by phone, email or through the program of Software. The contact details are listed in the table below:

In case if the time needed to take measures as for an error acknowledgement is longer than the time remaining until the end of the current service time, the time to take measures may extend to the next business day.

If the error acknowledgement is received outside of the service time, the time needed to make measures is extended to the next business day.

5.4.5. The Help Desk provided by the Kinepict does not cover the following cases:

- repairing the damage of the Software caused by unauthorized interference, external violent injuring, or improper use of the equipment;
- correcting the errors caused by viruses if this is due to User's fault or in case if this cannot be imputable to Kinepict;
- correcting the errors due to the failure of implementing /changing the technical conditions;
- repairing the damage/correcting the errors caused by force majeure. Can particularly be considered force majeure: technical break downs which cannot be corrected directly by Kinepict, a natural disaster that prevents or restricts the functioning of the Software, an adverse climatic event, a cyberattack executed by a hacker.

In the cases specified in this point, the cost of reparation the damage/correcting the errors shall be borne by the User.

## **6. Rights and Obligations of the Parties**

- 6.1. The Kinepict and the User declare that they have the appropriate expertise, qualifications, experience, items and resources to perform the cooperation under the present GTC.
- 6.2. The User can use the Software set out in Point 2 of the present GTC. The Kinepict shall not be liable and fully excludes any liability for any damage or consequential damage caused by medical diagnosis based on the using the Software.
- 6.3. By accepting the present GTC, the User acknowledges that if it does not ensure the technical conditions specified in the present GTC, the Software will not function. The Kinepict is not responsible for the dysfunction of the Software if it is due to a lack of technical environment.
- 6.4. The User is obliged to notify the Kinepict immediately but at the latest within 24 hours in the event there is an adverse event or serious adverse event regarding the Software. For avoidance of doubt the definition of adverse event and serious adverse event can be found in ICH E2D Guideline. ([https://database.ich.org/sites/default/files/E2D\\_Guideline.pdf](https://database.ich.org/sites/default/files/E2D_Guideline.pdf)). If the User doesn't fulfil his/her obligation set forth in this point, shall be liable for damages related to the breach of the obligation.
- 6.5. The User is ready to share with the Kinepict its experience gained in the course of the examinations while using the Software. The Kinepict undertakes to provide consultations to the User at a frequency to be determined by the Parties without disrupting the User's work process.
- 6.6. The Kinepict commits itself to assure on-site Installation and Training required for the cooperation. User shall provide the material conditions necessary for the Installation, as well as the time necessary for the Training of its employees.
- 6.7. Parties agree that all date, facts and information relating to the other Party of which they have become aware through the present GTC and individual agreement are business secrets. Such information, business secrets may not be used, disclosed to a third party, they may not be treated in any manner that violates or endangers the interests of the other Party, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the other Party.
- 6.8. The Parties state that all existing intellectual property provided to User under the present GTC and individual agreement are and shall be the sole property of the Kinepict. Parties acknowledge that all intellectual property (for example images made during the use of and the Software) created by the User without the assistance of the Kinepict in the course of the contractual and proper use of the Software is the exclusive property of the User. As for any other – not mentioned in the previous sentence – intellectual property and intangible assets created while or in connection with the performance of the GTC (including, in particular, any enhancement, supplement, or new version of the Software or any other product or service of Kinepict) shall be the sole property of the Kinepict and shall not be claimed by the User. The User acknowledges that in the course of the performance of the GTC, the current intellectual property and other intangible assets may be upgraded and their new version can be created in connection with the Software, or otherwise with respect to the Kinepict's products, services or activities, the result of which is wholly owned by the Kinepict, the User shall have no right to claim it. Each Party undertakes to make prompt statements to the other Party, upon request, in order to fulfil their intent based on this point.
- 6.9. The Kinepict is aware of the fact that the User is managing personal and health data. The Kinepict declares that it does not intend to access, store or use any personal or medical data under the scope of the present GTC, and

undertakes to immediately inform the User in case of any unexpected disclosure of such data, and to immediately stop access to such data. During the present GTC the Software may be connected to the User's picture archiving and communication system and DICOM system.

## **7. Fee**

7.1. Parties agree that the User shall use the Software for the fee (hereinafter referred as **Fee**) set forth in the Individual Agreement.

## **8. Payment of Fees**

8.1. The Kinect will invoice the Fee on the dates specified in the Individual Agreement. The Kinect shall issue an electronic invoice, which shall be sent the User to the e-mail address specified in the Individual Agreement, unless the User expressly requests that the invoice be sent by other mail.

8.2. The User undertakes to pay the invoices submitted by the Kinect by transfer to the payment account indicated on the invoice no later than the payment deadline.

8.3. The User shall bear any extraordinary costs (improvements to meet specific needs) resulting from any modifications, changes or fundamental conceptual changes requested by the User other than those provided for in the Individual Agreement, or other unplanned extraordinary costs, and in such cases the Kinect shall be entitled to separate remuneration for the additional work.

## **9. Warranty and liability**

9.1. Parties agree that the imaging system used by the User during the examinations and the Software can function parallelly, so any malfunction of the Software does not prevent the examinations from being executed. The Kinect shall have no liability and fully exclude any limitation for incorrect or inaccurate image proceeded by the Software. By accepting the present GTC the User acknowledges liability limitations, and exclusion of the Kinect.

9.2. The Kinect declares and User acknowledges that the Software is labelled with FDA and CE marking. Therefore, technology should only be installed and used in such a way that possibly malfunctions do not influence the normal workflow and the patient's care in accordance with institutional protocols.

9.3. The proper medical expertise is required for the functioning of the Software and for the use or evaluation of the results obtained from the use of the Software. The Software and the results obtained from the use of the Software, by themselves, shall not be used as medical diagnosis only a specialist can form any diagnosis on the basis of these results. The Kinect shall not be liable for incorrect conclusions, diagnoses or expert's opinions resulting from any malfunction of the Software or from its improper use.

9.4. The Kinect fully excludes any liability for any damage or consequential damage caused in an item of property and shall not be liable for any damage caused in life or physical integrity, either for any lost profit. In particular, the Kinect excludes any liability for damage caused in any item of property, in life or in physical integrity which occurred by the use of the Software for the purpose of official medical diagnosis. This limitation of liability does not apply to any damage caused by the Kinect deliberately, either to any damage caused by the violation of the provisions set forth in the Agreement which resulted in harming life, physical integrity or health. By accepting the present GTC, User accepts the limitation of liability fixed in this paragraph. You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the software.

9.5. The Software can only be used with the Authorized Person. The Kinect shall not be liable for any damage resulting from the use of the Software by any other person than the Authorized Person.

9.6. The Kinect undertakes to ensure the functioning of the Software within the technical conditions fixed in Annex 1 of the present GTC. If the technical conditions required to the functioning of the Software change for any reason not attributable to the Kinect, the Kinect will no longer be responsible for ensuring the functioning of the Software. If the technical conditions required for the functioning of the Software remain unchanged but an error has occurred in the functioning of the Software, the Kinect undertakes the correction of the error within the framework of the Help Desk Support of the GTC.

9.7. Kinect undertakes no warranty or liability with respect to the Software indicated in the GTC. This provision does not affect the availability and the repairing, maintenance, and training responsibilities of the Kinect determined by the GTC.

## 10. Communications

- 10.1. Parties agree that within the present GTC and the fulfilment of present Individual Agreement they are only the items posted by persons assigned to contact by the Parties (further referred to: Recorded Items) that are suitable to legal effect.
- 10.2. All written and received legal disclaimers that arrive via e-mail with the feedback of its reception, via recommended or return-receipted letter, by transport by a courier or by the personal handover of a courier with the written documentation of the date and the fact of the handover shall be regarded as Recorded Items. The date of the signature of the person who is entitled to receive postal packages shall be regarded the date of receipt in case of personal delivery or delivery by courier. In case of postal delivery, the date of receipt is the day signed on the return receipt or the day when the delivery was attempted if the address denied the receipt. In case of two unsuccessful deliveries (the package is returned with „the address cannot be identified”, „the recipient is unknown”, „not searched for”, „the recipient has moved”, „delivery was impeded”, „the addressee has ceased to exist” signals) the fifth workday after the second attempt of postal delivery shall be regarded as the receipt date.
- 10.3. The User agree about statements in connection with this GTC that every declaration they get in letter or via e-mail arriving from a contact defined in this GTC shall be regarded as deriving from a person who is entitled to make that declaration.
- 10.4. Parties assign the persons in the Individual Agreement in connection with the fulfilment of the present GTC.
- 10.5. Parties are obliged to inform the other Party immediately in case of any change in connection with the contact persons or the contact persons' contact data in written form. Consequences from the omission of this duty does not load on the other Party. The change of the contact persons or the contact persons' contact data does not infer the necessity of the modification of the Agreement.

## 11. Litigation and Applicable Law

- 11.1. Parties claim that they are entitled to form the present GTC, their contracting capability is not limited, and they are not acquainted with any legislative or other obstacles of forming this contract.
- 11.2. The provisions of the GTC, the interpretation of the GTC and issues that are not regulated in the GTC shall be governed by the laws of Hungary.
- 11.3. In case of any dispute among the Parties in the context of the GTC or the fulfilment of it, Parties are obliged to make every move they are able to in order to arrange the dispute in a peaceful way. If negotiations performed in case of peaceful arrangement do not lead to success within 30 days, Parties submit themselves to the jurisdiction of the Hungarian court or the entitled authorities. Each party will comply with the Data Protection Laws applicable to it; Kinepict Data Privacy Notice can be found at [https://kinepict.com/app/doc/Privacy\\_policy.pdf](https://kinepict.com/app/doc/Privacy_policy.pdf)
- 11.4. Parties hereto shall cooperate with each other to achieve the purpose of the present GTC.
- 11.5. In case of either Party does not practice their rights deriving from the GTC immediately or completely it does not automatically infer their resignation from this right. At the same time, it does not infer the prolongation of the legislative or contractual deadlines.
